## Natural Gas Forum Sparks Local Interest

Around 100 people attended a community forum in Winchelsea on 23 July to learn more about SP AusNet's natural gas project.

The project will see Winchelsea residents and businesses connected to natural gas before winter 2016.

Representatives from SP AusNet and Surf Coast Shire were on hand to answer questions, following a presentation from SP AusNet Program Manager, Geoff Thorn.

Mr Thorn said the attendance and nature of questions indicated a solid demand for natural gas in the area.

"There was a genuine level of interest and anticipation," he said. "People were keen to know when they could get connected and what they had to do. They could already see the advantages of natural gas."

"They talked about waking up in a warm house, having plenty of hot water, cooking in a wok on a gas stovetop, as well as the lower cost. These things can really make a difference to your day-to-day life," he said.

Mr Thorn acknowledged the State Government's role in bringing natural gas to Winchelsea.

"We're able to connect towns like Winchelsea to natural gas because of the Victorian Government's *Energy for the Regions* program," he said.

"We look forward to connecting more Victorians to our natural gas network."

"Meanwhile, we'll be doing our best to minimise disruption to the people of Winchelsea during construction. Safety will be our highest priority."

In the last five years, SP AusNet has carried out works costing more than \$580m to bring natural gas to more than 92,000 homes and businesses in western Victoria.

Under the previous State Government's natural gas extension program, SP AusNet connected gas to 12 Victorians towns: Barwon Heads, Camperdown, Creswick, Gisborne, Lancefield, Macedon, Maiden Gully, New Gisborne, Port Fairy, Riddells Creek, Romsey and Woodend.
