## AusNet Services “finalist” in national safety award

AusNet Services' 'We Keep Each Other Safe' safety campaign has been chosen as a finalist in the National Safety Awards of Excellence.

Held by the National Safety Council of Australia, the 2014 awards attracted more than 150 nominations, with AusNet Services' campaign nominated in the Best Communication of a Safety Message category.

AusNet Services Manager, Health, Safety, Environment and Quality, Rocky Armstrong, said being named as a finalist is great recognition for the company's focus on safety.

“AusNet Services is committed to safety, hence, we're very proud that our 'We Keep Each Other Safe' campaign has been recognised as a finalist in the national safety awards,” Mr Armstrong said.

“Importantly, the campaign itself was highly successful with approximately 400 metropolitan and regional employees involved in creating nearly 50 entries expressing what 'We Keep Each Other Safe' meant to them.

“The strong employee response proved this was a highly engaging campaign, putting safety in the forefront by creating safety discussion and debate across the organisation,” he said.

The campaign complements AusNet Services' safety program, missionZero, which includes 'stop for safety days' and safety leadership training.
